
The NEW 2018 **Inclement Weather Policy**

Increases in the Ticket Costs for the Dances and Dinner for 2019

To help stem the current Dinner loses, we are going to increase Dinner Ticket pricing by two (2) dollars in 2019. Member Dinner prices will be \$12.00 dollars and Non-Member prices \$13.00. A full Dinner "Income and Expense" Report will be given in the "March-April" Telescope.

For the Dinners, currently, it is estimated that we will or could lose between \$1,100 to \$1,400 dollars for 2018. As you all know, LaRosa's charges us \$7.50 dollars per plate to cater our Dinners. For both Chef Henry and Hammann's catering, they each charge us \$10.25 dollars per plate. In 2018, We sell our dinner tickets at \$10.00 dollars per plate for Members and \$11.00 for Non-Members. Weighted averaging indicates that we should break even considering ticket price versus Caterer price. But that is not the problem. Each beer permit, for both the Dances and the Dinners, costs \$40.00 Dollars each. Entertainment for the dinners equals \$125.00 dollars per evening. The costs for the Dinner "Beer Permits" and the "Entertainment" are labeled "Fixed Expenses". In layman's term, that means whether you have one person show up or 100 people show up, you still pay \$165.00 (\$40 +\$125). On a per plate basis for 100 diners that is \$1.65 per plate. Remember, we charge \$10.00 dollars and the Caterer charges \$10.25 per plate. Adding that \$0.25 difference (ticket vs Caterer) to the \$1.65 per plate, you get a loss of \$1.90 dollars per plate, not counting the other fix costs. And there are. All the Board is saying is," ... Yes! We are willing to take a loss but how much????" Please remember a flank steak and chuck roast is about \$7.99 per pound and a chicken breast is \$2.69 per pound. And for 2019, who knows?????

Now the Dances. Chairperson Nancy Thinnes Merz told the Board,"... that the average attendance at the dances is now between 65 and 80 dancers per dance." For 2018, Band prices ranged from \$270 to \$300 per band. These prices are or will go up in 2019. These are fixed costs. Add to that cost, the beer permit and the bartenders, which adds another \$150.00 dollars. Dance tickets are only \$6.00 dollars each. We are the cheapest Saturday Night Senior Dance in the neighborhood. Go check. DJ's for dances are \$350 to \$450 dollars.

The G.T.S.C.A. only has two major means in earning expense monies - Dinners and Dances. You know that "Split-the-Pot" game, will for the 2018 Dinners, it reduced our loss by \$800.00 dollars.
