A POD is a location where medications or vaccines will be distributed to residents in Hamilton County. It will be opened if many people within our community have been exposed to an infection that may make them sick and disease from that infection can be prevented by antibiotics or a vaccine. In order to reduce travel, wait time and provide a familiar location Hamilton County will have many community-level PODs.
